HURRICANE DEBRI PICK UP

Large, Bulky Storm Debris

WHAT: Large branches, tree trunks, bushes Fence panels, other bulky storm debris

PICK UP DAY: Beginning 9/15

LIMIT: No limit

PLACEMENT: Curbside, please do not place large debris in driveways, in yards or on the street. Large debris can be bundled. Please do not bag. Place away from utility boxes, fire hydrants and mail boxes. Following these guidelines will expediate pickup and permit the use of heavier equipment.

Small Storm Debris

WHAT: Bagged leaves, palm fronds, rakeable brush

PICK- UP DAY: Weekly -Wed. & Sat.

LIMIT: 5 bag/50 lbs each

Placement: Curbside

FREE DROP OFF SITE

Located at 3540 Dike Rd. Winter Park to drop off vegetative storm debris. Be prepared to unload yourself. Acceptable debris includes branches, tree trunks, bushes& rakeable debris. No fences or construction debris accepted.
